Option 1: Upper Manhattan (including Central Park)

1. Go to the Apollo (253 West 125th Street)
 - a. What are two shows that are currently playing?

2. Visit the John Lennon Imagine Memorial in Strawberry Fields in Central Park (Central Park West and 72nd Street). Make a rubbing of the "E" in imagine by placing a piece of paper over and rubbing it with a pen or crayon.
3. Go to the Central Park Conservatory.
 - a. How many main garden areas are there? _____
 - b. How many fountains are there in the Conservatory.
 - c. Describe one of the fountains.

4. Head to the Metropolitan Museum of Art (1000 5th Avenue at 82nd Street). They are closed on Mondays. They have a "pay as you wish" entrance fee - meaning as much or as little as you want to pay!
 - a. Count the number of stairs heading to the main entrance. _____
 - b. Get a map or floor plan from the museum.
 - c. Go in and visit the Tomb of Perneb in the Egyptian galleries. Go in it! Describe some of the hieroglyphics you see.

Option 2: Midtown Manhattan

1. Go to the Empire State Building (350 5th Avenue between 33rd and 34th Street) and enter through the 5th Avenue entrance.
 - a. Look at the mural. Who painted it? _____
 - b. What information did you learn about the mural? State two facts.

2. Go to the Public Library (5th Avenue at 42nd Street)
 - a. Go through security - and smile and be nice!!
 - b. If they have a floor map available - grab it!
 - c. Go upstairs two flights.
 - d. Look up!! Describe the artwork you see on the ceiling. Shhh... you are in a library!

3. Go to Grand Central Station (42nd Street between Lexington and Vanderbilt).
